Mark L. Levitt Reappointed by Supreme Court of Illinois

Levitt will again serve on the Capital Litigation Trial Bar Screening Committee

DEERFIELD, IL – Sept. 14, 2010 – The Illinois Supreme Court notified Mark L. Levitt that he has been reappointed to the Capital Litigation Trial Bar Screening Committee. Levitt, who has been an assistant public defender with the office of the Cook County Public Defender for 20 years, was first appointed to the committee in 2006.

Capital cases are among the most complex cases in the judicial system. The Capital Litigation Trial Bar Screening Committee reviews the qualifications of attorneys who wish to practice in capital cases to ensure that “counsel possess the ability, knowledge and experience to do so in a competent and professional manner.” The Supreme Court of Illinois appoints members of the screening committee.

Mark Levitt is a resident of Deerfield and a candidate for Circuit Court Judge in the 4th Subcircuit of the 19th Judicial Circuit (Lake County).
